Clark County Democrats Choose Seth Evans

Evans replaces withdrawn County Commissioner candidate.

At a Special Meeting held on Thursday, August 9th, the Clark County Democratic Party Central Committee selected Seth Evans to replace Pamela Dixon who was nominated for County Commissioner in the May Primary Election.
