2. **Death reviews (drug death, child death, suicide):** Participate with other Clark County professionals in review of accidental drug deaths, child deaths, and suicides in Clark County to determine if additional actions and/or resources may be needed.
3. **Mass fatality preparedness:** Participate in mass fatality drills; cultivate and maintain relationships with emergency management, first responders, and neighboring counties to be prepared for a Clark County mass fatality.
